### ENTRIES

The application for participation can be submitted by an individual person, club or the team captain who represents a specific Ski Association and the athlete.

The application for Baltic Cup races must be submitted through online registration form that can be found at [www.suusaliit.ee/et/mkalender](http://www.suusaliit.ee/et/mkalender). The registration must take place no later than 48 hours before the start of the race according to Baltic Cup 2020-2021 alpine ski competition rules.

### RACE OFFICE AND TEAM CAPTAIN'S MEETING

Race Office will be located in front of the main building (cafe house under the front slope) of Munakas ski resort. Bibs and lift tickets for U12, U14, U16 and M will be handed out in the race office from **7.45**.

## ENTRY FEES

Entry fee of EUR 20.00 per racer discipline will be charged.

**Entry fees and lift passes need to be paid together.** This means that the payment per day per racer will be EUR 20.00 entry fee + 11.00 lift pass. Passes will be handed out at the race office together with bibs.

## LIFT PASSES

For race days, 13th and 14th of March, we have provided a special lift pass price for racers which is EUR 11.00 per athlete per day (normal price EUR 38.00). **This price is for racers only and lift passes need to be paid together with the entry fees via bank transfer as mentioned before.**
